“Visit Jordan – Land of the Prophets & Al-Aqsa, the Third Holiest Site in Islam”

7 Days / 6 Nights – Group Program (2026)



Itinerary:

Day 1 : Arrival Q.A.I airport - Amman (Dinner)

Arrive at Queen Alia Int'l. Meet, Assist & then transfer to Amman.

Overnight in Amman

Day 2 : Blessed Tree – Ahl Al Kahf (Seven Sleepers) (Breakfast /Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to the Blessed Tree that is situated in east of Jordan, where Prophet Mohammad (PBUH) had taken shelter more than 1400 years ago. After that, he made Dua for this tree. So, believe it, the tree is in the same condition, and yet not dry and withered away. Indeed, this is perfect proof for those, who have faith on one Allah. The Tree is still standing despite of several difficult seasons.

Continue to Ahl Al Kahf (Seven Sleepers) whose story is mentioned in the Holy Quran, the story of seven young men during Roman times (Pre-Byzantine) escaping persecution for worshipping only one God. And seeking refuge in a cave, they slept in the cave and when they woke up they had no idea that they had slept for 300 years. The 'sleepers' thought they had only slept for a few hours. After their story was widely known, the 'sleepers' died. Then, continue to your hotel in Amman.

Overnight in Amman

Day 3 : Nabi Shuaib – Nabi Ayyoub – Nabi Yoshaa – Allenby Bridge – Jerusalem (Breakfast / Dinner)

After breakfast, continue to Al Salt City to visit the shrines of Nabi Shuaib (PBUH), Nabi Ayyoub (PBUH) and Nabi Yoshaa Bin Noon (PBUH). Then, transfer to Allenby Bridge for departure to the Holy Land. Meet & assist and continue Jerusalem.

In the evening, attend a spiritual orientation session introducing the special status of Al-Aqsa Mosque in Islam, its role as the first Qiblah, and its connection to Makkah and Madinah. The day concludes with Maghrib and 'Ishā' prayers at Al-Aqsa Mosque, allowing pilgrims to begin their ziyārah with calm reflection, worship, and renewed intention (niyyah). Continue to your hotel in Bethlehem.

Overnight in Bethlehem

Day 4 : Al-Aqsa Mosque Ziyārah & Worship (Breakfast / Dinner)

The day begins with Fajr prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque, followed by a guided Islamic ziyārah within the Haram al-Sharif. Visit key sacred sites including Al-Qibli Mosque, the Dome of the Rock, and Masjid Al-Buraq, with explanations grounded in the Qur'an and Sunnah. Throughout the day, we are given ample free time for individual worship, du'ā', Qur'an recitation, and quiet reflection. Short spiritual reminders and Hadith reflections enhance the experience, making this day the spiritual heart of the journey. Back to your hotel in Bethlehem.

Overnight in Bethlehem

Day 5: Prophets of Palestine (Breakfast / Dinner)

After breakfast, we travel to Hebron (Al-Khalil) to visit the Ibrahimi Mosque, where the graves of Prophet Ibrahim, Prophet Ishaq, and Prophet Ya'qub (peace be upon them all) are located. The journey continues with a visit to Maqam Nabi Musa, associated with Prophet Musa (peace be upon him). Back to your hotel in Bethlehem.

Overnight in Bethlehem

Day 6 : Allenby Bridge – Mu'tah – Amman (Breakfast / Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to Allenby Bridge. Then, transfer southwards to the battle field of Mu'tah. It was fought in 629 (8 AH) near the village of Mu'tah in Karak, between the forces of the Islamic prophet, Muhammad and the forces of the Eastern Roman (Byzantine) Empire. During the battle, all three Muslim leaders fell one after the other as they took command of the force: first, Zayd Bin Haritha, then Jafar Bin Abi Talib, then Abdullah Bin Rawahah. Then, continue to your hotel in Amman.

Overnight in Amman

Day 7 :Amman - Q.A.I airport for departure (Breakfast)

After breakfast, transfer to Q.A.I airport for departure.

- **Visa-Required Nationalities: Visa must be obtained from Israeli consulate**
- **Exit Tax at Land Borders (2026):**
 - **Allenby Bridge: 208 ILS**
 - **Other land terminals: 120 ILS**
