 **November 22, 2026 – Day 1**


 **Departure from the United States**

 **Overnight Flight to Uzbekistan**

Enjoy your overnight journey to Uzbekistan. Upon arrival, **early hotel check-in** will be arranged to ensure your comfort and allow time for rest after travel.

 **November 24, 2026 – Day 2**

Uzbekistan Welcome to Tashkent

Upon arrival in Tashkent, you will be transferred to your hotel for **early check-in** and time to refresh.

Later, enjoy an **orientation tour** of Uzbekistan's capital—a city that beautifully blends rich Islamic heritage with modern development.

Highlights include:

- **Chorsu Bazaar:** One of Central Asia's oldest and most vibrant markets, known for its iconic blue dome. Experience local culture while exploring spices, fresh produce, traditional foods, and handcrafted goods.
- **Tashkent Metro:** Renowned as one of the most beautiful metro systems in the world, with artistically designed stations such as Kosmonavtlar, Alisher Navoiy, Paxtakor, and Mustaqillik Maydoni.
- **Independence Square:** A peaceful and symbolic landmark representing the nation's pride and history.



 **November 25, 2026 – Day 3**

Tashkent to Bukhara (High-Speed Train)

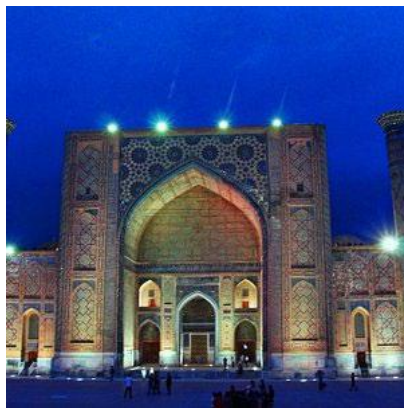
After breakfast, transfer to the railway station and board a **high-speed bullet train** to the historic city of **Bukhara**.

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel (standard check-in from 2:00 PM).

Bukhara is one of the oldest cities along the Silk Road and has been a center of Islamic scholarship, trade, and culture for centuries.



Admire the intricate tilework and architectural harmony of the historic educational institutions of the **Madrasas of Ulugbek and Abdulazizhan** - built in the 14th/16th centuries



Ancient Covered Oriental Markets (16th-17th centuries) Step back into the Silk Road era as you

explore traditional trading domes offering carpets, handicrafts, spices, and local goods. Some historic hammams are still in operation today. Visit one of Bukhara's most iconic landmarks, **Poi Kalon Complex** - featuring a grand mosque, towering minaret, and historic madrassah



 **Visit:**

- **Lab-i-Khauz Complex:** A serene architectural ensemble from the 16th–17th centuries, centered around a historic pool and surrounded by madrasahs and traditional structures.

 **November 26, 2026 – Day 4**

 **Bukhara to Samarkand**

After breakfast and hotel check-out, continue exploring Bukhara’s rich heritage before departure.

 **Highlights:**

- **Ark Fortress:** A historic citadel dating from the 5th–20th centuries, once the residence of Bukhara’s rulers and a symbol of political power.

Later, transfer via **high-speed train to Samarkand**.



Sitorai Mohi Hosa Palace built during the 19th–20th centuries. Visit the elegant summer residence of the emirs, blending Eastern and European architectural styles, and home to fascinating historical exhibits



In the afternoon, transfer to the railway station and board a high-speed train to **Samarkand** - one of the most legendary cities along the Silk Road. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel, followed by an optional lunch and a relaxed evening walking orientation tour. Overnight Samarkand.

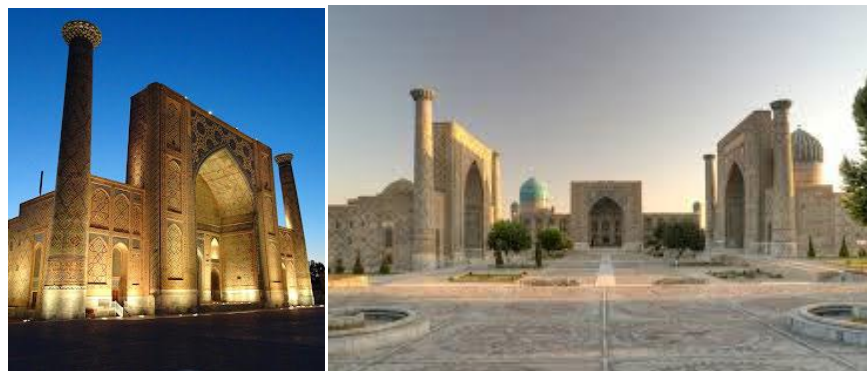
 **November 27, 2026 – Day 5**

 **Samarkand – Jewel of the Silk Road**

Explore the legendary city of Samarkand, where history, culture, and Islamic heritage converge.

 **Key Sites:**

- **Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum:** The resting place of Amir Temur (Tamerlane), an architectural masterpiece from the 14th–15th centuries.
- **Registan Square:** The heart of Samarkand, surrounded by three magnificent madrasahs—Ulughbek, Sherdor, and Tillakori—renowned for their intricate Islamic artistry.



Walk through this sacred avenue of mausoleums, **Shah-i-Zinda Necropolis**, renowned for its breathtaking tilework and spiritual atmosphere. Visit one of the largest and most impressive mosques of the medieval Islamic world, **Bibi Khanum Mosque**, built 14th–15th centuries in honor of Amir Temur's wife.



Enjoy time at leisure in **Siyob Bazaar** this vibrant local market, where you can experience authentic daily life and shop for traditional goods, spices, and souvenirs.

 **November 28, 2026 – Day 6**

 **Departure from Samarkand – Arrival in Madinah**

After hotel check-out, enjoy free time for **last-minute shopping and personal exploration** before transfer to the airport.

Arrival in Madinah Al-Munawwarah

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Take time to rest and absorb the tranquility of the blessed city of our beloved Prophet ﷺ.

 **November 30, 2026**

 **Guided Ziyarat of Madinah**

After Fajr Salah and breakfast, depart around **8:00 AM** for a spiritually enriching ziyarat tour.

 **Sites include:**

- **Masjid Quba:** The first mosque in Islam. Praying two rak'ahs here carries the reward of one Umrah.
- **Jabal Uhud & Martyrs of Uhud:** Visit the resting place of Sayyiduna Hamzah رضي الله عنه and the companions.
- **Date Farm Visit:** Enjoy fresh dates and a peaceful environment.
- **Drive-by Historical Sites:** View important landmarks tied to early Islamic history.

This ziyarat is a journey of reflection and connection to the legacy of Rasulullah ﷺ.

 **December 1, 2026**

 **Madinah Museum Experience (9:00 PM)**

Visit the **Best of Creation Museum**, located in As Safiyah Museum & Park.

This immersive experience highlights the Seerah (life) and noble character of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ in an engaging and educational format.

 **December 2, 2026**

 **Journey to Makkah & Umrah**

 Travel to the Sacred City of Makkah via high-speed train.

- Be ready in the hotel lobby at the designated time
- Upon arrival, check in and rest briefly
- Proceed for **Umrah at Masjid Al-Haram**

After completing your Umrah, dedicate your time to worship, reflection, and prayers.

- **Jabal Al-Noor (Cave Hira):** Site of the first revelation
- **Revelation Exhibition**
- **Mina, Arafat, Muzdalifah & Jamarat (Drive-by):**
 - Mina – City of tents
 - Arafat – Site of the Farewell Sermon
 - Muzdalifah – Plain of gathering
 - Jamarat – Symbolic stoning site

This tour strengthens our understanding of the Hajj journey and Islamic history.
