- Haramain High-Speed Train travel from Madinah to Makkah.
- Opportunity to visit Rawdah Al-Sharifah, subject to Nusuk booking and availability.
- Group support, air-conditioned ground transportation, and coordinated transfers throughout the program.
- Dedicated time for worship, reflection, additional tawaf, rest, and personal activities.



Day-by-Day Program

CAIRO, EGYPT

DAY 1 | TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2026

Arrival in Cairo

Cairo, Egypt

Welcome to Egypt. Upon arrival, the group will be met and assisted before transferring to the hotel for check-in and rest.

- Arrive at Cairo International Airport at approximately 7:45 PM.
- Obtain the Egyptian visa on arrival (approximately USD \$25 per person; not included in the package).
- Complete immigration and baggage collection, then meet the local ground team in the arrivals area.
- Private group transfer to the hotel, check-in, and time to settle in after the journey.

Please note: Arrival time and airport procedures may vary based on the final airline schedule and immigration processing.

DAY 2 | WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2026

Ancient Egypt: Giza Pyramids, Sphinx & Egyptian Museum

Cairo, Egypt

After breakfast, begin the first full day of touring with an orientation and a guided introduction to the great monuments of ancient Egypt.

- Breakfast at the hotel followed by a short group orientation with the tour leader.
- Depart at approximately 8:00 AM for a full-day guided sightseeing program.
- Visit the Pyramids of Giza, one of the most recognized ancient sites in the world.
- Visit the Great Sphinx and learn about the history of the Giza Plateau.
- Continue to the Egyptian Museum to view an extensive collection of ancient artifacts, including treasures associated with Tutankhamun.
- Return to the hotel after the day's touring program.

Cairo: Islamic Heritage & Friday Program

DAY 3 | THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2026

Islamic Cairo & Cultural Treasures

Cairo, Egypt

Today focuses on Cairo's Islamic, cultural, and historic heritage, with visits to important museums, mosques, and traditional districts.

- Breakfast at the hotel before departing with the local guide.
- Visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization.
- Tour the Citadel of Salahuddin and the Mosque of Muhammad Ali.
- Enjoy lunch at Al-Azhar Park with panoramic views across historic Cairo.
- Continue to Khan Al-Khalili Bazaar and Al-Muizz Street, known for Islamic architecture, traditional markets, and historic landmarks.
- Return to the hotel after the evening visit.

DAY 4 | FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2026

Jumu'ah in Cairo & Nile Dinner Cruise

Cairo, Egypt

A balanced Friday program combining congregational prayer, personal time, and a memorable evening on the Nile.

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Attend Jumu'ah prayer with the group at a local masjid in Cairo.
- Time between scheduled activities may be used for rest and personal needs.
- At approximately 7:00 PM, board a scenic Nile River dinner cruise.
- Enjoy dinner and traditional onboard entertainment before returning to the hotel.

DAY 5 | SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 2026

Cairo to Madinah

Madinah, Saudi Arabia

Depart Egypt for the blessed city of Madinah. The remainder of the day is planned around arrival, hotel check-in, and worship.

- Early breakfast at approximately 4:30 AM followed by hotel checkout.
- Depart for Cairo International Airport at approximately 5:00 AM.
- Scheduled flight: Cairo to Madinah, approximately 8:00 AM departure and 10:50 AM arrival.
- After immigration and baggage collection, transfer to the hotel and leave luggage with the bell captain if rooms are not yet ready.
- Standard hotel check-in is expected after approximately 3:00 PM.
- If a suitable Nusuk appointment is available, guests may visit Rawdah Al-Sharifah.

Please note: Rawdah access is controlled by the Saudi authorities and is subject to Nusuk availability; it cannot be guaranteed by the tour operator.

DAY 6 | SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 2026

Madinah Walking Tour & Museum Visit

Madinah, Saudi Arabia

Spend the day becoming familiar with Madinah and its historical atmosphere while preserving ample time for prayers at Masjid An-Nabawi.

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- At approximately 9:00 AM, join a guided walking tour in Madinah.
- Return for prayer, rest, and personal worship during the afternoon and evening.
- After Isha, depart for a scheduled museum visit at approximately 10:00 PM.
- Return to the hotel after the museum program.

Madinah Ziyarah & Spiritual Reflection

DAY 7 | MONDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2026

Historical & Spiritual Ziyarah of Madinah

Madinah, Saudi Arabia

After breakfast, travel with the group leader and Imam for a guided visit to important sites connected with the Seerah and early Islamic history.

- Mount Uhud - site associated with the Battle of Uhud.
- Masjid Quba - the first mosque built in Islam.
- Masjid Al-Qiblatain - historically associated with the change of the Qiblah.
- Area of the Battle of the Trench and the Seven Mosques, subject to current local access regulations.
- Return to the hotel with the remainder of the day available for prayers and personal worship.

Please note: Site access and routing are subject to Saudi regulations, traffic conditions, and local operating rules.

Overnight: Madinah

DAY 8 | TUESDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2026

Worship, Reflection & Farewell Group Dinner

Madinah, Saudi Arabia

A lighter day in Madinah allows guests to focus on prayer, Qur'an, personal reflection, and final time in the Prophet's Mosque before departing for Makkah the following day.

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Open time for worship at Masjid An-Nabawi, rest, and personal activities.
- Guests who have not yet visited Rawdah may continue to check Nusuk for available appointments.
- After Maghrib, gather for the group farewell dinner in Madinah.
- Return to the hotel and prepare Ihram and luggage for the journey to Makkah.

MAKKAH AL-MUKARRAMAH

DAY 9 | WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 2, 2026

Ihram & High-Speed Train to Makkah

Makkah, Saudi Arabia

Today the group prepares for Umrah and travels from Madinah to Makkah by Haramain High-Speed Train.

- Breakfast between approximately 6:30 AM and 8:00 AM.
- Prepare Ihram and attend a group briefing covering travel logistics and Umrah guidance.
- Private transfer from the hotel to Madinah train station.
- Board the Haramain High-Speed Train to Makkah, with expected departure in the approximately 12:00 PM - 1:00 PM window.
- Upon arrival, transfer from Makkah station to the hotel for check-in and rest.
- Later, perform Umrah with guidance and support from the group Imam/leader.

Please note: Train times are subject to final ticketing. Guests should follow Haramain baggage rules and keep essential Ihram items easily accessible.

DAY 10 | THURSDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2026

Makkah Ziyarah: Sacred & Historical Sites

Makkah, Saudi Arabia

Join a guided historical tour of key locations in and around Makkah associated with the Seerah, Hajj, and early Islamic history.

- Jabal Al-Noor and the area of Cave Hira.
- Jabal Al-Thawr and the area of Cave Thawr.
- Maqbarah Al-Mu'alla, the historic cemetery of Makkah.
- The plains of Arafah, where the central rites of Hajj take place.
- Jabal Al-Rahmah (Mount of Mercy).
- Return to the hotel with time for worship at Masjid Al-Haram.

Please note: Stops and access are subject to local permissions, traffic, crowd levels, and safety conditions.

Final Worship & Return Journey

DAY 11 | FRIDAY, DECEMBER 4, 2026

Free Day for Worship & Departure Preparation

Makkah, Saudi Arabia

The final full day is intentionally kept open so guests can make the most of their remaining time in the sacred city.

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Personal time for salah, Qur'an, additional tawaf, shopping, rest, and reflection.
- Prepare luggage and complete hotel checkout according to the group's final departure schedule.
- Evening transfer to Jeddah International Airport at approximately 9:00 PM.

Overnight: Makkah / Overnight travel

DAY 12 | SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2026

Departure via Istanbul & Return to the USA

International Travel

Conclude the journey with the return flight home, carrying the memories and spiritual benefits of the program.

- Scheduled departure from Jeddah via Istanbul at approximately 2:25 AM.
- Connect onward to the United States according to the final confirmed airline itinerary.
- Please keep passports, boarding documents, valuables, and essential medications in carry-on baggage.

Please note: All flight times are approximate and must be reconfirmed against the final issued airline ticket.

Important Travel Notes

Egypt Visa	Approximately USD \$25 on arrival as stated in the original program; not included in the package.
Rawdah	Entry is subject to Nusuk appointment availability and Saudi authority regulations.
Touring	Site sequence may be adjusted by the local guide due to traffic, prayer times, closures, or government restrictions.
Transportation	Private group transfers are coordinated around the scheduled flights, hotels, and Haramain train.
Schedule	Times shown in this program are approximate and may change once final airline, train, and supplier confirmations are issued.
